Oversee Southern Housing's resident involvement strategy and monitor its delivery 6. Monitor the diversity of members in the whole resident governance structure, recommending steps to ensure membership is representative of the resident population.

Meetings	Meetings can be in person, remote (teleconference or video conference) or hybrid.		
Frequency of meetings	Resident Strategy Group will meet at least quarterly. It will also meet at least once a year with the Board.		
Decisions	Decisions at meetings will be reached by consensus. Where consensus cannot be reached, a vote should be taken. If required, the Chair has the casting vote. When required, urgent decisions can be agreed by email / telephone between meetings.		
Appointment of members	Members will be appointed in accordance with the Resident Recruitment Policy.		
Appointment of Chair / Vice- Chair	The Chair can serve for up to six years. (e.g. two three year terms). Using the process set out in the resident recruitment policy.		
	The Vice-Chair will be elected every three years or as needed by Resident Strategy Group members from among its membership. The Vice-Chair can serve for up to a six years. (e.g. two three year terms).		
Link to Board	The Chair of Resident Strategy Group will be appointed a member of the Board's Residents Service Committee.		
Reporting	The Resident Strategy Group will share key messages with Board, resident governance panels, Southern Housing employees, resident governance panels and wider residents as necessary.
